12TH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST (12TH AUGUST) THEME: ANGER TO LOVE

REFLECTION ON THE THEME

The readings this week affirm that life is full of struggle and that by nurturing ourselves with the Bread of Life and being attentive to the presence of God with us throughout, we may indeed turn anger to love.

The writer of Ephesians tells us that it is okay to be angry, but that we must not allow anger to cause us to hurt others, or to act against God's will. Rather, we are called to harness our anger in ways that lead to love. The nuance in this passage is important because it provides validation to those who are victims of pain and injustice that their anger is legitimate. This week's Hebrew Scriptures give voice to the pain of the people, while the gospel reading provides a deeper reflection on what it means to love as Christ loved us. We are to become the bread of life for one another, by sustaining each other in hardship and reconciling with each other in times of conflict. In what ways do the people of God together live as a transforming influence in a world hungry for love?

John 6:51 - I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live for ever; and the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh.'
