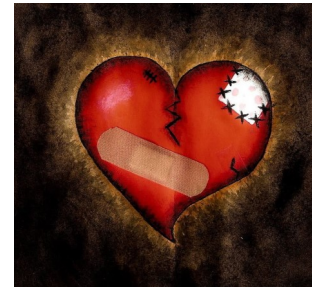
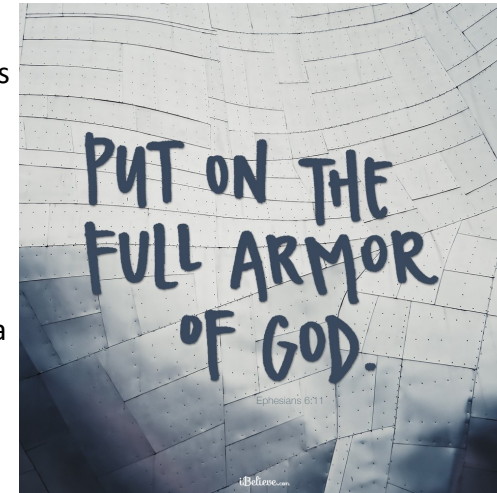

THEME: LOVE IS OUR DEFENCE

Reflection

Our reflections on the Letter to the Ephesians over the past few Sundays concludes today with the encouragement to cover ourselves with spiritual practices that will enable us to "stand firm" on the way of God.

Sometimes, the close of New Testament letters feels like a final "take care" called by a parent as a child sets out the door into the world (see Romans 16:25-27, for example). The senders of these letters know the challenges that will come the way of their sisters and brothers in Christ, and seem to want to protect them but all they can do is offer a warning and encouragement to be diligent in the practices that will reinforce the strength of Christians and Christian community – prayer, honesty, peacemaking, kindness.



The letter to the Ephesians uses military imagery to describe how a new Christian community is to prepare for the struggles for justice, wholeness, harmony. The faithful are encouraged to derive strength from God's strength. What follows is a detailed metaphor which exhorts the people to put on the "whole armour of God" which is truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and, most of all, love.
