### THEME: LIVING WISELY

#### Reflection

When King Solomon becomes king the one thing he prays for is **wisdom** to understand how to govern his people well. This theme of "living wisely" is echoed in the Ephesians reading with the exhortation to live as wise people seeking to understand the will of the Lord.

Wisdom is such an important concept in the bible that it is personified as a representation of God. An alternative Old Testament reading for today is Proverbs 9:1-6 : *Wisdom has built her house, she has hewn her seven pillars. She has slaughtered her animals, she has mixed her wine, she has also set her table. She has sent out her servant-girls, she calls from the highest places in the town, 'You that are simple, turn in here!' To those without sense she says, 'Come, eat of my bread and drink of the wine I have mixed. Lay aside immaturity, and live, and walk in the way of insight.'*

Jesus in describing himself as 'living bread' draws on wisdom imagery. He is offering food that leads to life, and elsewhere in the Gospels describes himself as "a child of wisdom" (Luke 7:35). May we, like Solomon, pray for wisdom.
