
## ICE CREAM CRAWL

### **St Peter's Memorial Garden**

You will know from our Parish Vision summary that developing a strategic plan for the memorial garden is a current priority. Parish Council are finalising the creation of guidelines for the use of the garden. Part of this work is an increase in fees from 1st July 2018 and the introduction of a non-refundable component to the fee.

**New Fee as of 1st July 2018 will be \$1000.00 for a permanent site (\$500.00 non-refundable upon cancellation of booking)**

The fees have not risen for many years and currently there is no non-refundable component. Which means that the parish currently holds a large liability for previously paid for but unused sites. During the year you will be further informed of progress and invited to respond to submissions about the garden.
