THEME: DOERS OF THE WORD


Reflection

Our acts of generosity reflect our belief that every perfect gift comes from God. Saint James describes two types of generosity. Generosity of spirit is exemplified by listening and being slow to anger. Generosity of effort and provision is demonstrated in caring for widows and orphans. There is a challenge here for individuals and churches to put faith into action.

At the heart of this passage is the imperative to be "doers of the word" and "not merely hearers". Jesus told a parable about two sons, one of whom promised to help but didn't and one who said he wouldn't help but in the end he did. This simple teaching reminds us that our actions speak louder than words, and our words will only have any impact if our actions match them. This morning we pray that we can "walk the talk" in our Christian lives and be "doers of the word".
