THEME: Setting our minds on divine things

Reflection

In this parish we know well the story of Saint Peter recognizing Jesus as the Messiah and, as a result, being named as the rock of foundation for the church and given the keys to the kingdom. However just a few breaths later he is called a stumbling block to Jesus and castigated for setting his mind on human things rather than on divine things.

We may feel a fair bit of sympathy for Peter, surely we too would have doubted the wisdom of a Messiah who claimed he had to suffer and die.

Divine Wisdom is different to human wisdom. Our Old Testament reading and canticle invite us into reflecting upon Divine Wisdom in a way that might defy our human reasoning. We are also invited to see that Divine Wisdom is mightily powerful and pervades every aspect of creation.
