Gospel Reflection

Today the famous account of the "widow's mite" in Mark 12 gives us a lasting example of overwhelming generosity. It also becomes the occasion for Jesus to predict the downfall of the temple and condemn the scribes who "devour widow's houses". A great measuring stick of society's compassion in Jesus' time was the community's care for widows, orphans and strangers in the land. We too can ask: how well cared for are the most vulnerable in our community? No society or church ever does this perfectly, but we continue to aspire to be generous in our giving and receiving of love, care and compassion.
