Reflection

Approaching life with the willingness to be surprised is a spiritual practice. We often think we know the results. When we believe we can predict the outcome, we start to underestimate ourselves, judge others and withdraw our faith from God. Sometimes, God asks us to be open to the possibilities, to take another look, and to try again. Like a boat full of fish... or someone who unexpectedly needs our help.... or a calling to help out a new church. You never know when you might be surprised by God's call.

Consider the first verse of a song that our 10am congregation will sing:


Will you come and follow me if I but call your name?
