PRIEST'S LENT MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

We have started the season of Lent which is considerably later this year, with Easter falling on Sunday 21st April. Last Sunday I preached that Lent is a gift for us. It is a reminder every year to focus on deepening our faith. The traditional practices of Lent (Fasting, Giving and Praying) have broadened in meaning to encompass a range of things we can try. These practices are not ends in themselves but are reminders of God's love and salvation and the immense importance of that in our lives.

Fasting these days can be interpreted in a whole range of ways like giving up certain foods, or giving up TV, or iPad games, or perhaps giving up something else that will serve as a reminder.

Giving could be a range of things like giving to charity, or giving our time to help another or spending time valuing and deepening our important relationships. Praying can encompass a whole range of spiritual disciplines like finding quiet time to pray, or bible reading, attending discussions, reading a spiritual book, going for walk, meditation and so on.

Please note the opportunities we are offering with the Lenten Benediction meditations led by Brett, and the Lenten Cafe Church led by myself and Michele as good Lenten opportunities to grow this Lent. You can come along to any or all.

Guest Speaker - Lorna Fenech

Lorna is the Principal of Adelaide West Special Education Centre, a school for students with complex communication needs and a range of additional disabilities. Lorna explains that: *"communication is a fundamental human right. Without communication we cannot express an opinion, build relationships or indicate preferences, among other things. The staff at Adelaide West teach communication throughout the school curriculum using a variety of augmentative and alternative communication systems."*

Lorna will demonstrate and explain the use of some of these systems and discuss strategies used to ensure the students reach their full potential.
