
SEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER EPIPHANY 24TH FEBRUARY 2019 THEME: LESSONS IN HOLINESS

Welcome to worship today. Our services at 7:45am and 8:45am begin on p.119 of the green prayer-book in your pew, and at 10am on the power-point screen

Reflection on today's Gospel reading (Luke 6:27-38)

Today's Gospel reading from Jesus' Sermon on the Plain (in Luke's Gospel) contains seriously challenging lessons for us. We are asked to do good to those who hate us; to bless those who curse us; to lend to those who won't pay us back; to love our enemies. If we're honest we have to admit this is very difficult teaching indeed. Could any of us have that much faith and forbearance?

We think we are not as holy as Jesus. But Jesus calls us to be like God, no less. "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful" is a call to delve into our own vulnerability to see our mutual need for forgiveness, healing, and restoration. The imperatives of this Sermon on the Plain set high standards, but Jesus is not asking us to be perfect on our own. Our holiness cannot be achieved alone but only through a merciful relationship with one another. Holiness, as God has created as our birthright, is wholeness. We cannot do it apart from divine love.
