THEME: FOOD FOR THE SOUL

Our 7:45 and 8:45 services begin on p.119 of the green prayerbook

Reflection

Both the Old Testament reading and the Psalm for today, speak of how God satisfies our deepest longings. Their words reassure us that God offers us food for the soul, an answer to our deepest hunger, that no earthly food can satisfy. In Paul's letter he talks about how God's people have taken God's gift for granted and sought satisfaction in inadequate substitutes.

The Gospel reading takes us into a very relevant area for this week, reflecting on why bad things happen. Jesus is quite adamant that the suffering of the people in the two examples being discussed with him, was not deserved by the victims in any way, nor was it due to their sinfulness. But he does use the discussion opportunity to point out that everyone needs to repent. He backs up that call for repentance with a parable that opens our eyes to God's patience, grace and forgiveness.

As we reflect on themes of innocent suffering, blame, justice and forgiveness we have the recent events of Christchurch in our minds. We continue to hold all involved in our prayers, we trust in God to feed our souls in these times and we repent of our own feelings of intolerance or prejudice and commit ourselves to be peace-makers in our communities.
