Reflection

God's word has the power to create, curtail, refine, shape, challenge, build, and plant. The power of God's word has been described over and over in scripture, yet we can forget to leverage its strength in our efforts to transform our lives and our communities. As we read this week's scripture readings, let us consider the ways that God's word could create, refine, strengthen, and replant our lives in a way that enlivens the Spirit, pleases God, and makes the reign of God more visible for all who seek hope in a hurting world.

The reading from Jeremiah reminds us that it doesn't matter if we feel insignificant, God calls us to speak his word anyway. The Gospel reminds us that the word is not always received openly. And the reading from 1 Corinthians 13 reminds us the God's word is love and the power of his love can overcome all of our deficiencies and will endure for ever.
