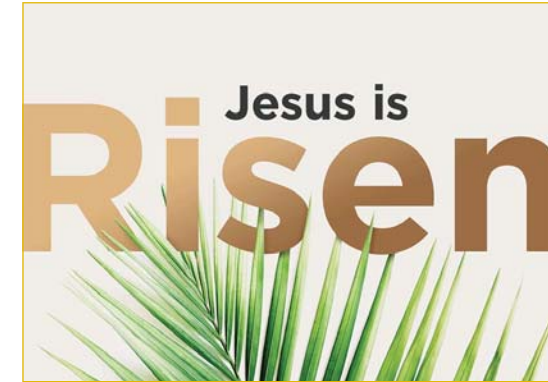

#### Reflection

Our journey through Holy Week began with Jesus' journey into Jerusalem on the back of donkey. On Good Friday we reflected on his arduous journey to Golgotha (the place of the skull) and his crucifixion. Today we encounter another journey - The journey of the Mary, Joanna, Mary Magdalene, the other women disciples and Peter to the empty tomb. An experience which leaves them wondering in amazement. But another journey later that day, reveals what has happened. The disciples journeying on the road to Emmaus, encounter the risen Christ walking with them. At first he is unrecognized as he explains to them the scriptures concerning the Messiah, but in the breaking of the bread the disciples recognize him and run back to Jerusalem to tell the eleven. As they pass on this news, Jesus appears to them with the words "Peace be with you."



***O Risen Christ, come stand among us

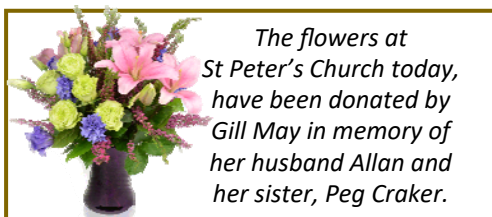
