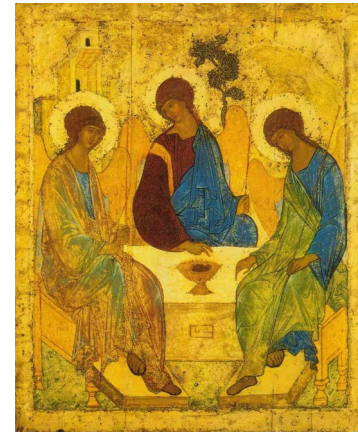
## THEME: GOD'S RELATIONSHIP WITH US

### Reflection

To make sense of the Christian doctrine of the Trinity you have to grasp one important word - Relationship! Relationship! Relationship! Relationship! Relationship! Repeating it is that important.

Rublev's classic icon of the Trinity captures the essence of this theme. The figures in the icon are equal but complementarily different, and they are visibly connected in relationship. Not only do they relate to each other but the circle they create is expressly open to the viewers who stand before it in prayer.



God's relationship of being is not just a relationship within the Godhead, it is a relationship with us also. Our salvation takes place **within** the divine relationship of love.

In recent years theologians have recaptured St John of Damascus' word **Perichoresis** (dancing around) to describe the activity of the Trinity. God is eternally moving through our lives, through the creation, through history and inviting us into this divine dance. That **is** God's relationship **with** us.
