Reflection on the theme

St Paul's letter to the Galatians is one of the earliest pieces of writing in the New Testament. It was possibly written as early as 50AD and certainly by 55AD - just 20 years after Jesus' death. The community of Jewish believers in Jesus was still grappling with how to incorporate new Gentile believers into their ranks and to what extent they should keep Jewish religious laws. Paul (although a Jew) is on the side of not making the Gentiles

follow these laws. The letter is a passionate plea for the Galatians to ignore the Judaizers (those advocating a return to the Jewish law) who have infiltrated the community.

This is the context for understanding today's New Testament reading [Gal 3:23-29] . Paul writes: "There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male or female. For all are one in Christ Jesus." [Gal 3:28] Paul points to a radical

equality that all believers now enjoy in Christ. We are in Christ! That is our salvation! We do no need to rely on purity laws and the like to make ourselves even more holy. He stresses the point "It was for freedom that Christ set us free. Therefore, stand firm and refuse to submit again to the yoke of slavery." [Ga; 5:1] For Paul: "All that matters is faith expressing itself through love." [Gal 5:6].

The challenge for us is to honestly examine distinctions we set up between people, especially within the community of faith, and do we focus more on the divisions or on the radical equality we enjoy because, as Paul tells us, "through faith you are all children of God in Christ Jesus." [Gal 3:26]


