# Reflection

Vision 2022 for the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide says: *Our vision and our yearning is that over the next five years we will be a Diocese of flourishing Anglican communities, united and connected, whose members are confident and competent to live as disciples of Jesus Christ in the power of the Holy Spirit.* This succinct vision connects very strongly with the vision of the early church at Pentecost.

At Pentecost the church began its life. Communities of faith sprang up around the Mediterranean and beyond. Given the limited means of communication at the time, the sense of unity and connection they achieved was amazing. Surely the Holy Spirit was at work bringing that unity (which is one of the key gifts and activities of the Spirit). Through the Holy Spirit the disciples of Jesus indeed found *confidence* and *competence* to spread the good news. The church was birthed by the power of the Spirit and in order for any church to grow and thrive, be it our parish or our diocese, it must rely on the activity of the Holy Spirit. Today as we celebrate Pentecost we don't just look back on an historical event, we participate in, and pray for, the continued activity and renewal of the Holy Spirit in our lives and within our community of faith. With Christians thoughout the ages we can indeed pray: Veni Sancte Spiritus - Come Holy Spirit.
