**Cash donations are also greatly appreciated - we'll do the shopping! Thank you.**

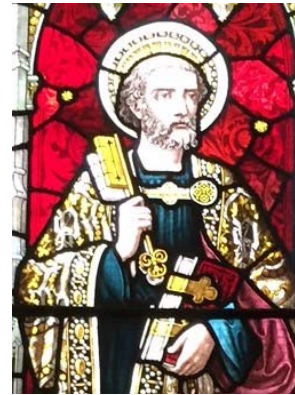

**Reflection**

We are blessed to have such a human patron saint in the person of Saint Peter. Peter's spiritual journey was one of gradually growing into deeper faith and leadership with many setbacks along the way. Our theme for the day is "On this rock" and it refers to Matthew 16:13-19, when Jesus asked his disciples who he was. Peter replied: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God" for this statement of faith, Jesus gives him (Simon as he was then known) the nickname "Peter" or "Cephas" in the Aramaic. A word unknown of as a name at that point. In the old testament God gave people new names to signify a new purpose in their lives. The nickname Jesus gave to people indicates this with a little touch of humour and affection too.

There are many times in the scriptures that Peter is more "rocky" in his faith than rock-like. But nevertheless the church is built on his faith. Not because he was perfect but because he persisted faithfully despite his failures. Peter is a great example for us, who likewise are not perfect, but are seeking to be faithful to Christ in this time and place.

### KITCHEN HELPERS for PLAYGROUP

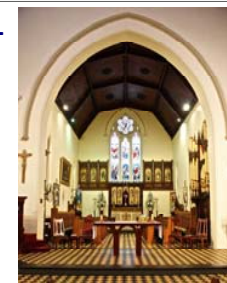
