## Reflection

It's a constant refrain that you often hear: "we are being asked to do more with less." The church is no different. It seems like there is so much opportunity, but we have limited resources—The harvest is plentiful but the labourers are few. It is consoling to realise that the people of the early church era in Luke's community felt the same. And probably every church community, no matter the resources at their disposal, has felt that way. We cannot do everything, but we can always do something.

So our prayer shouldn't be: "Lord how can we do it all?" but rather, "Lord what would you have us do next?"

To continue the metaphor of harvesting, St Paul in his letter to the Galatians stressed the importance of the fruits of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. If we are growing these fruits well, even in small numbers, and in small ways, then by God's Grace great things may still happen.
