Reflection

The themes of humility, trust and service in today's readings, are great thoughts to have before us as we conclude our vision week today and think about "being the church." Our vocation to be the church is our mission, our reason for being. It has been said that "mission is finding out what God is doing and joining in." This takes discernment. What does God want us to do and be? Yes certainly to be humble, trusting and serving, but how do we put that specifically into practice?

We were distracted last week as we launched our vision week by a fire across the road from St Peter's. Parishioners directed traffic, called emergency services, offered support and food to the resident, and checked if the emergency services people needed assistance. Was it really a distraction from commencing our vision week or a lesson for us to consider? Not that I am suggesting God would send a fire to teach us a lesson, far from it. But rather we can reflect that our mission is not just of our own devising, but a responding to the God moments around us. As we commit to being the church, we commit to paying attention to the things that God is calling us to do in every day.


