### Reflection

### Parish Vision Week

Jeremiah didn't think he could be a prophet because he was "only a boy" but God knew before he brought him out of the shadow of his mother's womb that he was destined to be sent to speak the words of God [Jeremiah 1:4-10] .

The psalm writer acknowledges too that God has known him since his birth and so he places his hope and confidence in God who is his rock of refuge. [Psalm 71:1-6]

The woman in the synagogue is recognised by Jesus as a beloved daughter of God and is brought out of the shadows of her ailment through his healing touch. It was against the law of the day to heal on the Sabbath, but Jesus defies such expectations to place his value not on the letter of the law but on the value of the individual and the importance of her liberation from the shadowy exclusion that long-time illness places on people. [Luke 13:10-17]

As we commence our **parish vision week** what are the shadows of fear or limitation that hold us back from being more fully sent by God? We take stock of all that we offer in our shared parish life and ministry and thank God for it. We also share together our hopes, dreams and vision for areas where we think God is calling us to do more. **This is our parish, our shared vision, let's all be part of it.**
