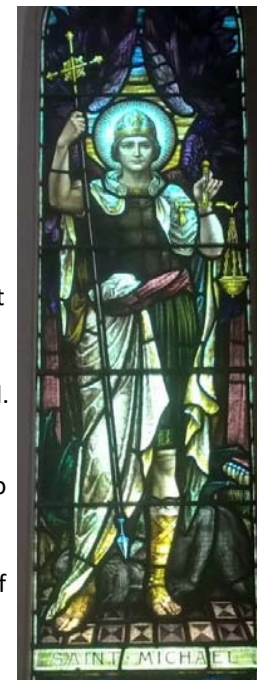
7:45AM & 8:45AM SERVICES BEGIN ON PAGE 119 OF THE GREEN PRAYER BOOK

Today on the feast of St Michael and All Angels (29th September) we celebrate the patronal festival of our St Michael's war memorial chapel at St Peter's church.

In honour of Archangel Michael we include in our readings today one of only two biblical references to Michael (Revelation 12:7-12). Many people find Revelation an awkward book and this has always been the case. Martin Luther called it "neither apostolic nor prophetic", Zwingli called it "Not a book of the bible" and it is the only book of the New Testament for which John Calvin did not write a commentary. This might reassure us that if we find parts of this visionary work difficult then we are in good company. That said, we can see in the book, and in this passage today, a vivid depiction of an epic battle between good and evil. St Michael is on the side of God and of goodness in that eternal fight.

The war memorial chapel built in 1920, commemorates firstly those who served and gave their lives in World War One and then subsequently in World War Two. As the people of this parish sought to commemorate their incredible sacrifice, it is not surprising that they saw the example of St Michael leading a cosmic fight of good against evil as an appropriate patron for this chapel. Take some time to look in the chapel and see the honour boards, particularly the handwritten one for WW1 and the brass memorial plaques in the sanctuary.

As we do this we note that the letter to Timothy reminds us to "fight the good fight" and to be "rich in good works". We also recall the words of the Jesus "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:3) As we give thanks for St Michael's chapel we also recognise those whom it commemorates. We pray for the ongoing protection of God's holy angels and we commit ourselves to living lives that are rich in good works so as to spread God's love and peace in our world.
