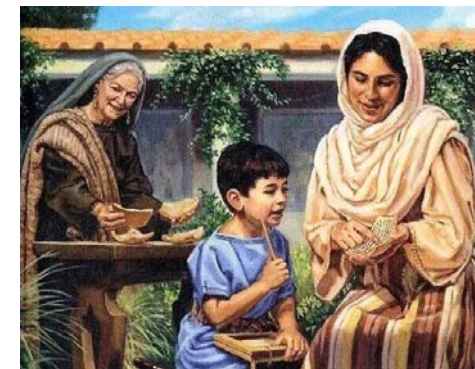

Reflection

One of the frustrating things about the New Testament is we get brief mentions of people who were clearly wonderful role models of faith, but we don't learn much more about them. A great example of this is Timothy's mother Lois and grandmother Eunice - figures that don't immediately leap to mind as heroes of the faith. The letter addressed to Timothy reminds him of the heirlooms of faith he has received. *"I am reminded of your sincere faith,*



a faith that lived first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, lives in you." [2 Timothy 1:5] As Timothy received the faith through Lois and Eunice, it leads us to consider those who passed on the heirlooms of faith to us. Maybe parents, grandparents, godparents or others who through their lives and their words have helped us to deepen our faith. We give thanks today for their good example.

In our Gospel reading today we are reminded that we don't need much faith to do amazing things for God. Faith just the size of a mustard seed can change the world. So today in our 10am service we will hear about two outreach ministries that help to change the world. Gideons International are holding their national convention in Glenelg this weekend and we welcome Ivan Gow to our 10am service. The Gideons have for many decades sought to distribute God's word to those who otherwise may not receive it. Also today we launch this year's Operation Christmas Child - Shoeboxes Of Love appeal. Brochures and shoeboxes should be available this morning. Please consider helping with this appeal as a small way of putting our faith into action.
