

#### Reflection

I was reminded by someone during the week of the beautiful hymn that starts: "Come as you are, that's how I want you, come as you are, feel quite at home. Close to my heart, loved and forgiven. Come as you are, why stand alone?" This person was saying they returned to church after a long absence and that was the first hymn they heard when they returned and it really moved them to keep coming to church. Perhaps this hymn captures the essence of what Jesus meant when he said to approach God like a little child. Without pretence, without fear, but just come as you are. This point is reinforced with the encounter between Jesus and the ruler sometimes described as the "rich young man" (Mark 10:17-22, Matthew 19:16-22, Luke 18:18-23) who, when Jesus invites him to "come as he is", is not able to leave the wealth he clings to for his identity and power.

To what degree can we be satisfied with who we are and what we have. We often cling to so many different things for our sense of self-worth and identity. But we need to strip all those things away to enter the kingdom of heaven. It is both daunting and liberating to know that we need nothing other than to be loved by God.
