Reflection

The healing of the ten lepers leads us to reflect on a number of points. One is that the lepers are not sent then healed, but rather they are sent first and in the process of going in faith, they are healed. This is not just because, as our sheep friend says below, that exercise is good for you, but because God needs us to step out in faith.

The next reflection to consider is the gratitude expressed by the one who returned to Jesus. Does this really mean the other nine were not thankful? Perhaps they did take their healing for granted, or perhaps they were thankful but they failed to express it. Perhaps they expressed their thanks at the temple. We don't know for sure, but we do have the example of the one who returned and made his thanks explicit to Jesus.

This lone Samaritan Leper stands strongly in our Christian heritage to remind us to live thankful lives. We should take time to acknowledge the people who bring love and healing into our lives and thank them for it. And, of course, we should give thanks to God every day. But what if I'm not feeling thankful? Even in the midst of the most dire of circumstances it is still possible to give thanks in some way. Is there someone you can say thank you to today? Is there something to thank God for?
