### Reflection

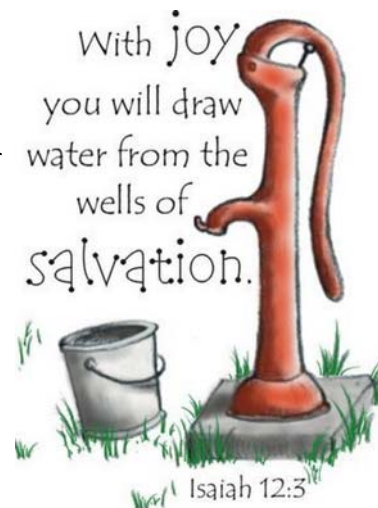
The beautiful vision of harmony and peace presented in Isaiah stands in stark contrast to the sense of threat in the Gospel reading from Luke. For Isaiah's readers they are returning from exile in Babylon and facing the task of rebuilding their lives back in their homeland. The vision of promise that Isaiah presents, gives them hope for peaceful homes and harmony on God's holy mountain.

In many ways the readers of Luke's gospel are facing an opposite situation. The Roman empire has destroyed the temple and persecutions are coming for the emerging church. Hardships will come, but these will be opportunities for sharing the Gospel and the believers are promised that, ultimately, "Not a hair on your head will perish and by your endurance you will gain your souls."

Thankfully in Australia we do not face these same trials although Christians in some parts of the world do even today. We pray for the church throughout the world that it may courageously live God's vision of promise for new heavens and a new earth.

We will trust and will not be afraid.  
God is our strength and our might.  
God has become our salvation.  
Sing praises to God. God has done gloriously.
