
THE CHRISTMAS BOWL APPEAL

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT 1ST DECEMBER 2019 THEME: BEING READY

Reflection

Today the season of Advent begins - a season to make ourselves ready spiritually to receive the birth of Christ. What does that mean? Isn't it just another Christmas? I think all of us are aware that this becomes a busy time of year and there is much to do before the Christmas deadline. In this context the advice of St Paul and St Matthew becomes very helpful. As St Paul says "now is the moment for you to wake from sleep" and St Matthew writes "keep awake". I take from this an invitation not to miss the signs of God in this season. Not to miss the invitation to ponder again the immensity of the incarnation. To reflect on the way God chooses to act in the world through the birth of Christ.

As we go through the process of getting ready - lighting the Advent wreath, opening advent calendars, putting up trees and decorations, buying presents and stocking the freezer, may each of these physical actions of getting ready remind us of the spiritual meaning behind it all - that Christ is born for us. Jesus is Emmanuel, God with us, born in poverty and humility, enfleshed in our human experience, that our human lives may be tinged with the divine presence and find meaning and transformation.

May you have a blessed Advent season

God of Hope, bless our Advent journey, strengthen our faith, secure our bonds. and enliven our imagination for a better world. Amen.
