Reflection

Jesus' parable about the unjust judge and the persistent widow is downright hilarious. You can imagine Jesus' listeners laughing at this unlikeable unjust judge who has to give in to the widow demanding justice because she simply will not give up hassling him. Jesus paints this scenario to encourage our persistence in prayer.

Is God like the unjust judge who only gives in to us so he can get some peace? No! As Jesus points out, if this unjust judge will eventually give justice then how much more can we rely on God to grant justice to his children who cry out to him.



We know from experience that justice can be slow in coming. We also know that tyrants and unjust structures do fall and justice and goodness can sometimes win out even against the odds. We can hear in this unlikely parable the invitation to persist in prayer even when injustice seems to be winning. Even then, persist faithfully in prayer.
