## LAST SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST 24TH NOVEMBER 2019 THEME: THE REIGN OF CHRIST THE KING

### Reflection

On this final Sunday of the Liturgical year we celebrate the feast of Christ the King. We sum up all that we have learnt of Jesus this year through Luke's Gospel. When we proclaim Christ as King we are not saying he is a king like any other earthly ruler. Rather the statement subverts our preconceptions regarding what kingship is all about. The Gospel reading today makes this very plain. Jesus' kingship is exemplified on the cross.

As W.H Vanstone said in his famous hymn  
"Morning Glory, Starlit Sky"

*Therefore He who Thee reveals  
Hangs, O Father, on that Tree  
Helpless; and the nails and thorns  
Tell of what Thy love must be.*

*Thou art God; no monarch Thou  
Thron'd in easy state to reign;  
Thou art God, Whose arms of love  
Aching, spent, the world sustain.*

Jesus' throne is the cross, forever conquered by the new life of resurrection. And the citizens of Jesus' kingdom are the least, the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those hungering for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, the persecuted and the reviled. For Christians, Jesus is king, not "throned in easy state to reign" but reigning in our hearts in peace and hope and love. Hallelujah! Thanks be to God.
