# Reflection

The Beatitudes in Matthew's Gospel are some of the greatest teachings in the Christian faith. They turn on its head what it means to be blessed. Jesus does not say that the wealthy, famous, beautiful and powerful ones are blessed but rather in God's kingdom those who are blessed are the poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers and the persecuted. It may not feel much like a blessing to be in any of those categories, but it does reassure us that God is on our side when we are struggling in such a way and God's compassion is with us and on the side of all those who suffer.


