Reflection

The theme of light comes through in our readings today. "The Lord is my light and salvation" [ps27:1]; "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light" [Is.9:2; Matt: 4:16] and in the beautiful prayer of the day by St Augustine, "Loving God, the light of the minds that know you."

Light is a deeply symbolic image. Not only does light enable us to see clearly in a practical sense, the gift of God's light enables us to see deeply, to understand clearly, and to walk confidently in God's salvation.

As Jesus called his first disciples in today's Gospel reading, we know he is calling them to walk in God's light. We too pray for faith to follow them and walk in God's light.

On this Australia day we also pray for the light of insight, love and strength to grow as a nation. We pray for the light of hope for all those suffering the affects of bushfire, for relief work and the slow task of rebuilding. We pray for the light of insight for students returning to schools in our nation this week. We pray for the light of compassion amongst those working for peace, understanding and reconciliation in our communities. We pray for the light of justice for those struggling with poverty and prejudice.

May light dawn on our land. May God's light always guide us.

Excavation Works for Salt Damp

Parishioners will notice the excavation works in the courtyard near the community centre. As you will be aware we have been raising money through last year to repair salt damp in the organ room and restore the lower western windows. We were unsuccessful in gaining a heritage grant for these works, but we have raised \$25,000 through our National Trust Heritage appeal. This will enable us to repair the salt damp and restore the courtyard to a usable space. We will continue to raise money for the western windows perhaps later this year. Please continue to support this appeal and we seek to care for our heritage properties.
